

Documentation of the consequences of eco-catastrophe: Kherson, Mykolaiv, Odesa, The rivers of Dnipro, Ingulets, and the Black Sea

- Monitoring of water and bottom sediments
- Fighting the consequences of floods, assistance to civilian citizens

On June 6, 2023, one of the biggest environmental and man-made disasters in Ukraine and Europe took place - the explosion of the Kakhovska dam. The wave rose to a height of 4-5 m. As a result, more than 63,000 hectares of forests and 5 settlements were flooded, and another 80 were destroyed by the flood. In total, more than 60,000 buildings with a total area of more than 5,800,000 m2 were flooded.

So we began our research, recently returned from a third environmental mission. However all the results showed significant excesses in the content of zinc, cadmium, and arsenic. That is, in no case can you drink water, even from wells, or eat local fish. These metals accumulate in the body and can lead to serious problems with the liver, heart, kidneys, and nervous system. We must continue these studies to see the changes in the ecosystem and develop a plan to restore them.

Now everyone must start balancing the systems - sorting waste, reducing their carbon footprint, etc.

We were the biggest environmental NGO in Ukraine before the war, and when the war started, we realized that we had so many people who could help others, and we became one of the biggest humanitarian families:
